The voter registration deadline for the Nov. 6 general election is Monday, Oct. 8. Register online if you have a Washington State ID or Driver License, in person at the Clark County Elections Office at 1408 Franklin St. in Vancouver, or by mail with a voter registration form available by download. In order to purchase tickets for this dance, all Battle Ground students will need to fill out and return a BLUE dance contract for yourself prior to ticket purchase in the ASB office windows. If you are bringing a guest from outside the school, a PINK dance contract will also be needed, filled out by you and your guest, parent signatures, and visiting school administrator prior to purchasing your tickets. Both BLUE and PINK contracts are now available in the ASB office. You must have your completed GUEST-PINK contract with you when purchasing tickets.

The first week to purchase tickets will be Monday, October 15 through October 19. The EARLY BIRD price for Oct 15– Oct 19 will be \$5 per person with ASB card (includes discount for guest ticket also) and \$10 per person without ASB. Beginning October 22nd the ticket prices will be \$10 with ASB per person and \$15 without ASB per person. LAST day to purchase dance tickets is Thursday, October 25 at 3 pm.

Now that pictures have been taken and you have been given your ID card, you are required to carry your student ID/ASB card with you at all times while on campus. You need to present your ID card at the ASB service windows to purchase any items or pay any fees/fines.
